

# PETITION FOR CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT UNDER ARTICLE X

All columns below must be complete for a voter's signature to be valid. In addition, a signature will not be valid if it appears on more than one petition.

To the Election Committee, Puyallup Tribe of Indians: We, the undersigned members of the Puyallup Tribe of Indians, being enrolled, propose an amendment to "Article III – Governing Body Section 2" of the Puyallup Tribal Constitution which would limit individuals elected to the office of Tribal Council to two (2) terms, only becoming eligible to run for office of Tribal Council after four (4) years out of office. and would provide a procedure for making that change. We hereby petition to have this proposed amendment referred to the voters of the Puyallup Tribe of Indians for their approval or rejection, and each of us for himself or herself says: I have personally signed this petition; I am a legal voter of the Puyallup Tribe of Indians; and my address is correctly stated. A full, true and correct copy of the proposed Constitutional Amendment under Article X is attached hereto and on file with the Election Committee and available for inspection by tribal members. 25 CFR, Part 81 requires that the Secretary of the Interior conduct a vote of the general membership to approve the amendment to the Constitution after receiving a resolution or petition signed by at least one-third of the eligible voters of the Tribe.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE III, SECTION 2  
OF THE PUYALLUP TRIBAL CONSTITUTION

Article III, Section 2 of the Puyallup Tribal Constitution shall be amended to read in full as follows:

Section 2. The Council shall consist of seven (7) members each duly elected to serve three (3) years, two (2) members being elected each year except that every third year three (3) members shall be elected. Individuals elected to the office of Tribal Council are limited to two (2) terms, only becoming eligible to run for office after four (4) years out of office.

This amendment shall take effect at the time of the first election following the adoption of this Amendment, at which election those candidates running for office shall be limited to two (2) consecutive terms, if so elected, prospectively from the date of adoption of this amendment.
